



International Traffic in Arms Regulation (ITAR)

International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR) is a set of United States government regulations that control the export and import of defense-related articles and services on the United States Munitions List (USML). Its goal is to safeguard US national security and further US foreign policy objectives.

All Active Silicon products, unless otherwise stated, are free from ITAR restrictions and controls on the basis that they are general purpose products and not manufactured specifically for any particular defense purpose. Any products imported into the US for the purposes of use in a defense application may be re-exported, **SO LONG AS NO APPLICATION SPECIFIC MODIFICATIONS HAVE TAKEN PLACE**. Under these circumstances, the following export classification may be used:

- Export Control Classification Number (ECCN): EAR99
- Schedule B Reference: 8471800000
- Country of Manufacture: United Kingdom

If any modifications take place in relation to a defense application in the US, Active Silicon warrants that only US citizens (typically employees of Active Silicon, Inc.) will be permitted to have knowledge of the modification and that this information will not be shared with any non-US citizens.
